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A Study of Student Perceptions of Ethical Values at University Level

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Abstract

This descriptive study was designed to explore student perceptions of ethical values at university level. The purpose of this study to identify the perceptions of student regarding ethical values. The main objective of this study was to investigate the ethical values of students, the importance of in their lives and how they are applying in daily different aspects of life. Data was collected through a survey questionnaire adopted from the research work were selected through sample random sampling technique. For this purpose, surveys were conducted to collect the data from 500 university students of both public and private sectors. The collect data was analyzed by using statistical package for Social Science (SPPS). It was concluded that students give more importance to ethical values in different aspects of life.

The study focused on three research objectives; To find out which ethical values university students consider useful in different aspects of life. To investigate which ethical values university students apply in different aspects of life. To identify the relation between ethical values considered important and applied in different aspects of life.

2. Material and Methods

The samples of this research were the students enrolled in B.S (HONS) programs of 4 conveniently selected universities from the District Lahore. Two universities were public and two universities were private selected for sample size. In Lahore district the Public universities were Lahore College for Women University, University of Punjab selected. In Lahore District the Private universities were University of Management & Technology, Minhaj-ul-Quran University, selected. In this selected universities the students were selected conveniently in the class B.S (HONS). Researcher takes 250 students from public and 250 from private universities which consists department of Education and Chemistry from Semesters number 1,2,7,8. The sample of this research was 500 students.



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The researcher has done the quantitative research by following the survey research design. The researcher collected the data visiting the institute of education and research in university of the Punjab Lahore. For the collection of data, the researcher personally visited in all these selected universities of both Public and Private in Lahore District. The researcher selected 500 students as sample from each of the mentioned universities from Public and Private sectors in Lahore District. The researcher selected students were randomly from each university. The researcher constructed questionnaire based upon the Ethical Values and each Ethical Values based upon the Importance and apply and allowed this numbers from importance and apply (1, to 10) The validity of the questionnaire was checked by the qualified person from L.C.W.U. the quantitative data was collected through 500 questionnaires which were statistically analyzed using SPSS-23.

3. Results and Discussion

We enrolled 500 students in our study of BS (Hons.) level from four public and private sectors universities (Lahore College for Women University Lahore, Punjab University Lahore, University of Management and Technology and MINHAJ University Lahore) of various semesters.

Table 1 indicates the number of male respondents is higher in private universities as compared to the number of male respondents in public universities. Similarly the number of female respondents is higher in public universities as compared to the number of female respondents in private universities. Table 1 also showed that the highest number of respondents were from chemistry department. The results about father education, mother education and annual family income were also given in Table-1.

The analysis indicates that students are highly satisfied with role of universities for a study of student perceptions of ethical values. Results revealed that student perceptions of ethical values are highly satisfied. Most of the students were agreed that they consider ethical values are important while raise the achievements. Most of the students had built positive relationship with each other to opt rewards or recognition based on their ethical values.
